| Democracy | Encouraging children to know that their views count -PSED work e.g. Class discussions/debates/circle time -Valuing all contributions/ideas -Children giving feedback Children contributing to decision making -Use of Voting (e.g. voting for which story we should read, voting which charity we should support with money raised during fundraising etc.) Equal opportunities for all |
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| Rule of Law | Understanding right and wrong Stories and discussion E safety stories and discussion Understanding that behaviour has consequences - School rules – Be your best self; dojos, golden time, School sanctions-3 warnings |
| Individual Liberty | Developing self-confidence, self-awareness and a positive sense of self Autonomy -Opportunities' for child initiated learning -Curriculum planning allows for children's interests to be valued Equal opportunities for all -Reflecting on differences in opinions/choices -PSED work e.g. circle time, class discussions |
| Mutual respect | Treating others as you wish to be treated -PSED work e.g. circle time, modelling positive interactions -School Rules to 'Be your best self' -Anti bullying week, friendship week, random acts of kindness Caring for the environment -Recycling -Looking after wildlife |
| Tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs and for those without faith | Learning about different faiths, places, people and celebrations -Faiths and celebrations (Chinese New Year, Harvest Festival, Holi, Diwali, Christmas, Bonfire Night, Easter) - Places and people (China, Africa, The Arctic) |
